Assessments are based on prior year's employment, sales, or production levels. Adjustments will be made annually for changes 10% or greater than prior year's levels.

Businesses with primary operations that reside outside of New York will be assessed a percentage of the appropriate category. The percentage will be an approximation of business conducted in NY relative to full operation.

Subsidiaries will be assessed separately from parent company. Each company will be assessed based on its own appropriate category and level.

All memberships are subject to Board approval.
